The City has received three applications for the vacant City Council position and two applications for the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.

Staff are currently reviewing the applications and conducting the necessary verification to ensure that all candidates meet the required qualifications. An update will be provided upon completion of this process.

City Council Position

The City Council will subsequently interview candidates for the vacant Council position at a Regular or Special Meeting, as determined by the Council. During that meeting, the Council will convene in Executive Session to evaluate the candidates and will then return to open session to make a selection, if they believe they have a candidate they wish to work with.

If a candidate is chosen for a council position, the City Clerk will administer the Oath of Office, at which time the selected individual will assume the duties of the position.

Parks and Recreation Advisory Board

The Boards and Selection Committee, consisting of Mayor Pro Tem Garcia, Council Member Prieto Duval, and Council Member Garza will conduct interviews of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board applicants in the Council Chambers at a date and time to be determined by the committee and coordinated with the City Clerk. Interviews for the board will take place at City Hall and include the City Clerk. Remember that interviews are to be fair, consistent and confidential.

At the next Regular Meeting following the boards interviews and if a selection is made, the Committee will present its recommendations to the full Council for consideration and appointment.
